15th Annual Golf Classic to hit hole-in-one for TLC-The Treatment and Learning Centers

Rockville, Md.—On June 5, approximately 200 golfers will participate in the 15th Annual TLC/Courtesy Chrysler Jeep Golf Classic. The event, held for the first time at Indian Spring Country Club in Silver Spring, benefits TLC-The Treatment and Learning Centers, a local, private non-profit organization that offers educational, therapeutic and vocational services to children and adults with disabilities. Since 1991, the tournament has raised more than a million dollars for TLC.

“The Classic is our signature event,” said Richard Pavlin, TLC executive director. “With so many exciting things going on at TLC this year—the continued expansion of the Katherine Thomas School, as well as facilities renovations, and a move for some of our services to a new location—we are anticipating a great turnout and a spirited tournament.”

In the last few years, the Classic has steadily increased the amount of money it raises for TLC operating expenses, which include scholarships and classroom aids, facilities improvement and maintenance and general operating expenses. This year, TLC expects to exceed the \$150,000 raised last year, bringing the 15-year fundraising total to more than a million dollars.

“TLC is doing great things for this community,” said Chris Zourdos, owner of Courtesy Chrysler Jeep. “We are proud to support them and to help improve the resources available for children and adults with disabilities.”

The event includes the golf tournament, as well as a silent auction and awards dinner. Special guest Al Koken of SportsTalk 980 will be on hand throughout the day and will deliver the keynote address at the post-tournament dinner. Also at the dinner, winners will receive their trophies, as well as gift certificates to the club pro shop. Additional event details:

- Registration begins at 9:30 a.m., and the golf tournament shotgun start at noon.
- Cocktails and a silent auction will follow the tournament.
- The day will conclude with an awards dinner and a live auction, including items such as season Washington Redskins tickets, diamond earrings, a full set of new golf clubs including the golf bag, and the SunTrust bank suite at the Verizon center for a Washington Capitals game next season.
