TLC's Annual Sno-Ball Softball Tournament Hits One Out of the Park

Tournament raises nearly \$20,000 for Rockville-based TLC—The Treatment and Learning Centers

Rockville, MD—[TLC—The Treatment and Learning Centers](http://www.ttlc.org) congratulates the winners of the [28th Annual Sno-Ball Softball Tournament](#). Despite more than an inch of rain the day before the games, sixty-one teams from the Washington, DC metropolitan area played more than 120 games, raising nearly \$20,000 for TLC—The Treatment and Learning Centers. TLC is a non-profit organization providing educational, vocational, and therapeutic services to children and adults with disabilities and typically developing children.

Patricia Ritter, Executive Director of TLC said, "We are so grateful to over 1,000 players and umpires who came out to play softball and supported individuals with special needs. In this economic environment, events like the Sno-Ball take on an even greater importance for a non-profit organization like TLC."

This year's 1st and 2nd place winners in each division are as follows: Co-Rec—Paperboys (Ellicott City) and Sullivans (Cheverly); 55+—High Street Bucs (Reisterstown) and Spicer's (Keedysville); Men's B/Super C—Ruppert Landscaping (Ellicott City) and Mamma Lucia's (Germantown); Men's C—Isagenix (Columbia) and Bluesox (Potomac); Men's D—Maggie Moo's (Laytonsville) and Dirty Birds (Baltimore).
