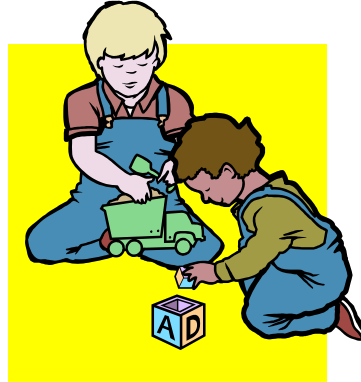
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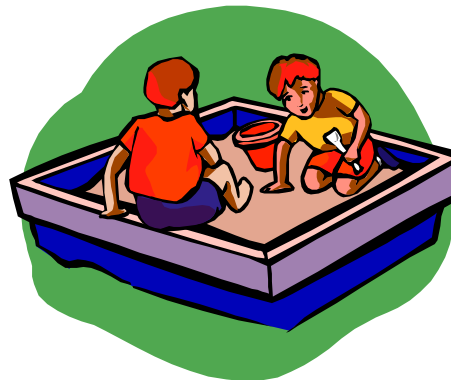
Interaction Groups

- ❑ Small groups with a maximum of 6 children
- ❑ Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays
Session A: 9 - 11:30 a.m.
- ❑ Tuesdays and Thursdays
Session B: 9 - 11 a.m.
- ❑ 12-week programs (approximately) through the year
- ❑ Class Fee - \$460 per week (T-TH group) and \$780 per week (M-W-F group)
- ❑ Payment arrangements and limited financial aid available
Credit Cards accepted
- ❑ Current speech-language and occupational therapy evaluations within one year required for application and admission to program
- ❑ Each child will be screened to ensure our group meets his/her needs



PURPOSE OF THE GROUPS:

To enable children between the ages of 2½ - 5 years to interact and communicate more effectively with others.



ABOUT THE GROUPS:



- Groups led by a licensed and certified OT and SLP, a licensed psychologist, and assistants.
- Group utilizes strategies and techniques from the Developmental, Individual differences, Relationship-based DIR® Floortime Model™/approach for intervention.
- Parent education and support groups, as well as parent training.
- Each child's needs will be addressed through an individual treatment plan that utilizes his/her own interests as themes to enhance attention and participation during individual, small, and whole group activities.
- Materials, toys, and equipment will be chosen based on each child's individual sensory and learning preferences.
- Facilitated play will be used to foster children's engagement, communications, and problem solving.
