TAKING STRIDES TO HELP TLC

Charity 5K Run Raises Funds for Rockville-based TLC-The Treatment and Learning Centers

Rockville, MD – On Saturday, November 19th, 167 individuals participated in the 1st Annual King of the Road 5K Run and 1 Mile Walk. The early morning race began and ended at TLC-The Treatment and Learning Centers' campus, and took runners through a three mile course around the Shady Grove Life Sciences complex.

The race was certified by the USA Track and Field Association, and organized by TLC with support of the Montgomery County Road Runners Association, who conducted the timing and scoring. All runner finish times were reported to the Washington Running Report. Runners from throughout the Washington Metro area, spectators, and TLC staff and friends joined in the awards ceremony, held at TLC following the race completion, to recognize the top three winners among the men and the women and those who finished first in their age group.

This inaugural event's signature sponsor was the King Automotive Group. More than \$12,000 was raised for TLC, a private, non-profit organization that offers educational, therapeutic, and vocational services to children and adults with disabilities. Additional event sponsors included Money Mailer, Mason Dixon Funding, and S. Freedman & Sons.

Race Marshals, Conrad Aschenbach and Lois Aschenbach, a former TLC board member, led the race and walk. Both Marshals' are representatives of the King Automotive Group.
